Mathematics, the queen of sciences, is enriched by several multifaceted personalities and as a result assumes the dimensions of a vast intellectual tree across the globe.

Prof. Vinod Prasad Saxena is one such unique mathematical personality who has made immense contribution in the field of Mathematics.

Born on Dec' 11 1943 in Shivpuri, Madhyapradesh, India, he took his M.Sc in 1966 with distinction from Jiwaji University Gwalior, Madyapradesh. Soon within a span of four years he was awarded Ph.D for his research contribution entitled "Integral Transforms and Their Technical Application".

At Post Doctoral level he worked as CSIR senior Research Fellow and Post Doctoral Research Fellow at SATI, Vidisha and M.A. college of Technology Bhopal from May 1969 to July 1971.

Besides, Dr. V.P. Saxena was a Visiting Scientist at the University of Cambridge, England. He was also a visiting scientist in 1978 under the British Council UGC (INDIA) Exchange of Young Scientists Programme and worked under Sri James Hill, Professor of LUC Asian University.

Besides being a professor, he was Dean, Faculty of Science, Jiwaji University, Gwalior from 1980-1986 and again from 1990-1992.

Dr. V.P. Saxena took over as emergency Vice Chancellor, Jiwaji University during August 9, 2000.

Dr. V.P. Saxena visited England, China, Singapore, Argentina, Turkey, Cyprus, Germany where he had delivered a series of lectures and presented scores of research papers on Mathematics and Engineering.

Dr. V.P. Saxena held diverse coveted positions such as

- President, Vigyan Parishad of India 2000-2007
- President, Gwalior Academy of Mathematical sciences 1994-1998, 2001-2005
- Vice President of Indian Society of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics 1986-1987
- Chairman, Computer Society of Indian Gwalior Chapter
- Vice President, Ramanujan Mathematical Society
- Academic Secretary of Ramanujan Mathematical society

Dr. V.P. Saxena organized several national and international conferences seminars, Symposia etc on Mathematics and Engineering.

Dr.V.P.Saxena guided as many as 24 Ph.D candidates and 30 M.Phil candidates for dissertations on Mathematics and all other related areas of Mathematical Studies.

Dr.V.P.Saxena published more than hundred research papers in reputed International and National Journals and presented about 150 research papers at various International and National Research conferences, Seminars and Symposia.

Dr.V.P.Saxena has to his credit twelve books on Mathematics and Engineering.

As a doyen of Mathematics Dr.V.P.Saxena received/won numerous prizes, awards and honors such as

- President of Indian cash prize for the best research paper in the 16th congress of Indian society of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics (Allahabad 1972)
- Hariom Ashram Bhaikaka parent prize for the best research publication during 1972-1973
